



Evacuation Go Bag

Small steps. Practical preparation. Keep this page where you can find it.

PACK ESSENTIALS

- ☐ Pack drinking water, portable food, medicines and hygiene supplies.
- ☐ Add first aid supplies, lighting, a power bank and weather information.
- ☐ Protect copies of contacts and key documents; include some cash.
- ☐ Add sturdy footwear, clothing and protection from local weather.

MAKE EVACUATION REALISTIC

- ☐ Plan a safe destination and transport rather than assuming wilderness travel.
- ☐ Include infant, pet and accessibility needs.
- ☐ Try carrying the bag and reduce weight you cannot manage.
- ☐ Keep it accessible and check supplies regularly.

SAFETY NOTE Do not delay an evacuation order to finish packing. Your destination and household needs determine what belongs in the bag.
