WATER, FOOD AND HEALTH

- ☐ Pack drinking water and no-cook food for several days.
- ☐ Include medicines, medical supplies and a first aid kit.
- ☐ Add pet supplies, infant needs and personal hygiene items.
- ☐ Use waterproof containers for documents, contacts and some cash.

POWER AND EVACUATION

- ☐ Charge phone power banks and pack cables.
- ☐ Pack flashlights, spare batteries and a weather radio.
- ☐ Add clothing, sturdy shoes and rain protection.
- ☐ Keep the kit portable and check expiration dates before storm season.

SAFETY NOTE A supply kit is not a reason to stay in an evacuation zone. Leave when officials direct you to.
