



Pet Emergency Plan

Small steps. Practical preparation. Keep this page where you can find it.

IDENTIFICATION AND CARE

- ☐ Update ID tags and microchip registration.
- ☐ Keep recent photos, vaccination records and veterinarian contacts.
- ☐ Arrange medicine supplies and species-specific care instructions with your veterinarian.
- ☐ Practice safe loading into carriers and vehicles.

PACK AND PLAN

- ☐ Pack food, water, bowls, leashes or carriers and waste supplies.
- ☐ Include familiar bedding and needed cleaning supplies.
- ☐ Confirm pet-friendly shelter or lodging options before an emergency.
- ☐ Choose a backup caregiver and include pets in household drills.

SAFETY NOTE Do not leave pets behind when evacuating if you can safely take them. Never assume every public shelter accepts pets.
