



Safe Gasoline Storage

Small steps. Practical preparation. Keep this page where you can find it.

CHECK BEFORE STORING

- ☐ Confirm local storage limits and fire rules.
- ☐ Use approved gasoline containers and only the amount you reasonably need.
- ☐ Choose a permitted location away from living areas and ignition sources.
- ☐ Keep containers secure and out of children's reach.

HANDLE AND ROTATE SAFELY

- ☐ Set portable containers on the ground when filling; follow station instructions.
- ☐ Turn engines off and let them cool before refueling.
- ☐ Label fill dates and follow stabilizer labels if used.
- ☐ Use only gasoline-rated transfer equipment; never siphon by mouth.

SAFETY NOTE Keep away from flames, sparks and heat. For a significant spill or strong fumes, leave the area and contact emergency services.
